**Passage:** Deuteronomy 8

1. How do you normally react when you are going through tribulation in your life? What's your first reaction?
2. Did you ever consider that it may be God who is leading you through some difficult time? What could be some reasons for Him to do it? Deut. 8.2-3, 5
3. Please read Deuteronomy 8.6-15. Why, do you think, God warns us to "be careful to follow every command" He is giving us (8.1), specially when we are in a good position and stable?
4. Why would God test our hearts? Does not Him already know what in inside of us? Deut. 8.2, Romans 16.10 and Hebrews 11.32-38
5. What are some of the lessons we can take from Deuteronomy 8.3-4. Compare to Isaiah 64.1-4
6. What should be our reaction when we understand that the source of our blessings is God and not us? Deuteronomy 8.17-20
7. Deuteronomy 8.16 affirms that God wants a happy end for us (please read it). What are some of the practical "happy ends" that we can observe in our lives through God's work and, what would be the outmost end-result that He intends to us? See Romans 8.28-29. James 1.2-4, Psalm 119.71 and Hebrews 12.5-6
